## **Creation of infrastructures for renewal of water sector defended**

Luanda - The secretary of State for Waters, Luis Filipe da Silva, on Tuesday here defended the creation of infrastructures so that the sector can serve citizens in a good way, taking into account the challenges and difficulties in matters of production and supply.

To the official, who was speaking at a forum on energy and infrastructures, the country needs to maximise synergies to profit efficiently from its hydric resources, mainly with regard to the distribution of drinkable water to the population.

The creation of infrastructures will bring about, in short and middle terms, good services and provide opportunity for private operators countrywide, which should give another dynamic to the sector.

"The creation of infrastructures is one of the ways of making the sector more attractive. It would attract many private operators and consequently generate a positive competition in this area, a fact that will enable to get incomes and guarantee this service to citizens", he said.

The mentioned forum had as goal to provide indicators for attraction of foreign investors, as well as debate opportunities of investments in the sectors of civil engineering, energy, mining and oil.
